



## Attention Junior Counselors!

**T**hank you for your interest in *Airways*, Baltimore Washington Medical Center's annual asthma camp for children, ages six to 12. This program is designed to provide an entertaining and educational experience for children with asthma who might not otherwise be able to participate in a day camp. During the program, children will learn about asthma, and participate in sports and other fun activities, such as swimming and arts and crafts. Pediatric nurses, respiratory therapists and other trained volunteers staff the camp.

The camp runs Monday, August 3 through Friday, August 7 from 8:30 a.m. until 4 p.m. at the Woods Memorial Presbyterian Church in Severna Park. Junior counselors must arrive at camp no later than 8:30 a.m. to help the campers get settled before each day begins. Junior counselors are required to bring their own lunch Monday through Thursday. We will provide lunch on Friday.

Junior counselors are also required to provide their own transportation to camp. Junior counselors may also carpool, which can be arranged at the Junior Counselor Orientation in July.

## Your Responsibilities at Asthma Camp

- ☀ Be a mentor for three to four campers. The assigned campers always remain with their junior counselor. If a camper goes to the bathroom, the junior counselor goes also and arranges for another junior volunteer to take responsibility for the rest of the group.
- ☀ Greet campers in the morning and help them get settled.
- ☀ Assist the campers with their activities, i.e. asthma education, arts and crafts, outside games. SERVE AS A ROLE MODEL!
- ☀ Participate in all activities, such as swimming, outdoor games and assisting campers with arts and crafts.
- ☀ All campers bring their own lunches. The junior counselor makes sure each camper has the right lunch because many campers have food allergies. Beverages will be provided, but some children will bring their own. Junior counselors are also required to bring lunches.

*All Junior counselors must wear the Airways t-shirt during camp.*

This orientation will provide an overview of the entire camp and allow counselors to meet the parents, campers and staff. Attendance is required for first-time campers and optional for returning campers.
